


# Seaside Rock Trail 1 - High St., Church St., Church Causeway & Tinkers Lane.

Start anywhere you like on the trail. All of the answers are clearly visible from the trail and you don't need to enter any private property or cross any roads unless specifically mentioned in the instructions.
